Field of activity:

DiXi Group's activities::

- **Analytical Research:** DiXi Group conducts in-depth monitoring and analysis in the energy sector, specifically regarding market operations, transparency, energy efficiency, sanctions, and other related issues. The think tank's team studies the impact of reforms and integration into European energy structures.
- **Advocacy and Public Education:** The organization promotes the adoption of new governance rules and standards in energy policy. It also works to raise awareness among the public, government officials, and the business community about the importance of transparent governance in the energy sector, fostering dialogue among all stakeholders.

- **Policy Development:** DiXi Group develops recommendations and proposals for government authorities on reforms in the energy sector and climate policy, providing support for the legislative process in Ukraine.
- **International Cooperation:** The think tank collaborates with international partners, which helps facilitate Ukraine's integration into global energy markets and expand cooperation with European countries. It also helps coordinate assistance provided to energy companies by international partners.

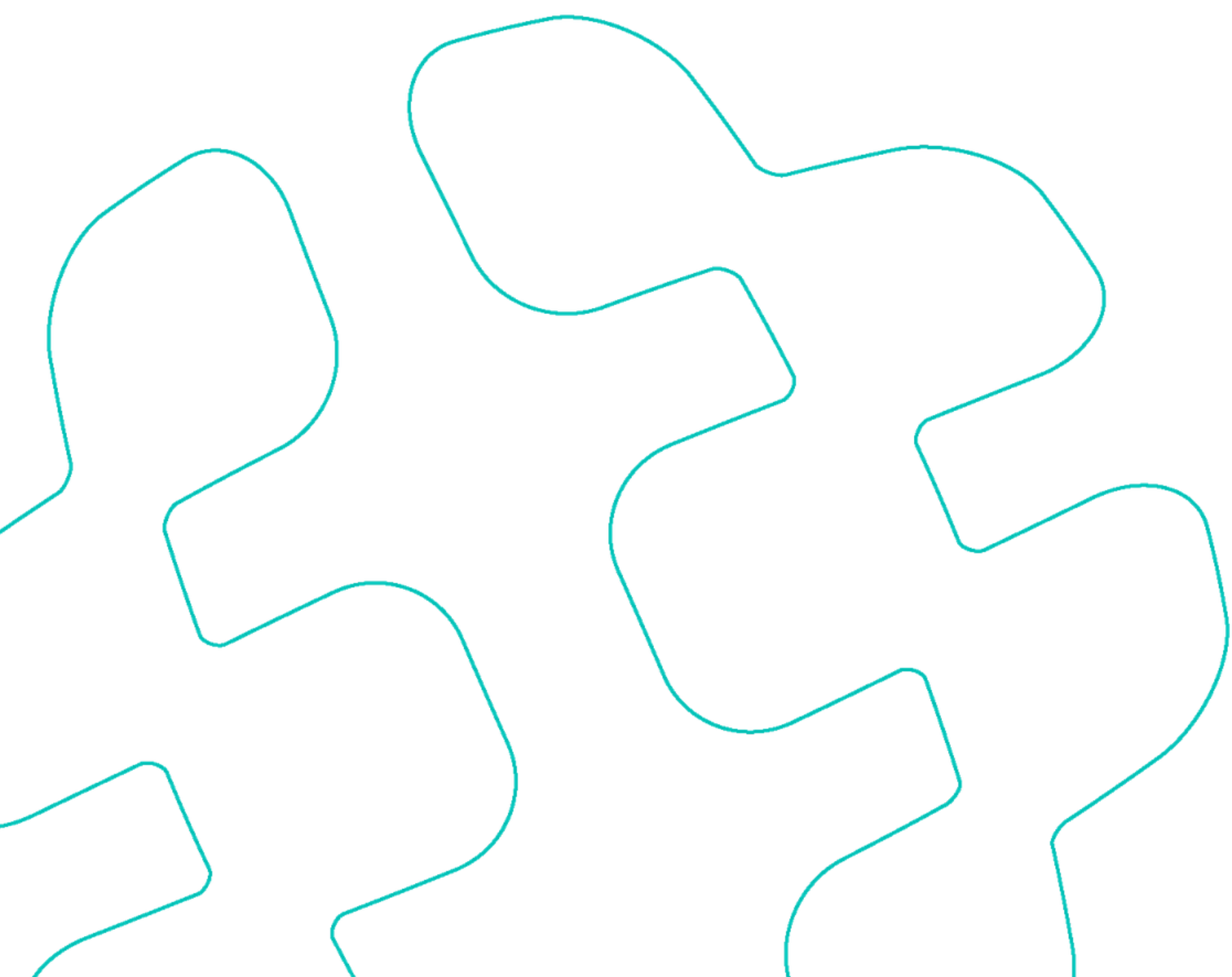

- **ENERGY MARKET DEVELOPMENT:**

The department works on analyzing and improving the electricity and natural gas markets. It develops proposals and recommendations for government agencies regarding energy sector development and integration into European energy structures. It has created the “Energy Transparency Index”—a tool that allows monitoring the dynamics of openness in the Ukrainian energy sector, including in comparison with other countries.

- **SECURITY AND RESILIENCE:**

• OPEN DATA:



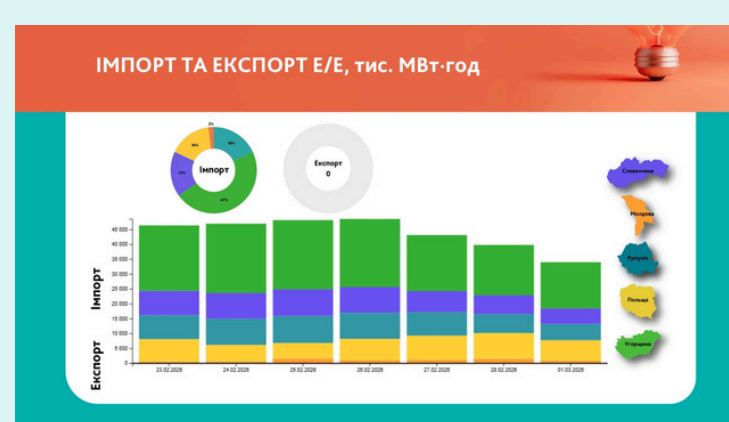
